Preamble

Human behaviour is much influenced by the environment he/she is surrounded by. Architecture, environment and behaviour have a dynamic relationship best explored by understanding the psychological, social and cultural factors that influences it. Harmonious exchange between space and people, enables the ability of humans to play social and cultural roles along with basic human needs of overall well-being. This process of action and reaction with the environment is also termed as environmental psychology. A truly interdisciplinary area of research and practice, this confluence of architecture and behavioural sciences provides a framework to understand the 'human- environment' nexus resulting in truly" humanised spaces" promoting health, well-being, inclusivity and comfort.

Key takeaways

This training program for teachers in the field of architecture aims to help them understand how the study of behavioural sciences at various scales can inform better design guidelines for the built environment, from individual buildings to entire cities. Experts from the fields of psychology, architecture, and social sciences will collaborate to discuss this broad topic and provide insights into the nuances of behavioural sciences in architectural environments.

Objectives

The goal is to explore how the built environment influences human perception, cognition, and social interaction, while integrating behavioral science concepts such as psychology, anthropology, and cultural studies into architectural design. It emphasizes environmental psychology as a framework for understanding how spaces shape behavior and well-being. This initiative also fosters interdisciplinary collaboration and equips participants with the tools needed to design environments that effectively support human needs, social roles, and cultural expression.
