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PREAMBLE:

The five-day workshop is envisioned as an exploration of the view points of the various stakeholders: the academicians, the architects, the consultants and the developers, under the highly relevant area of building and sustaining Man made Environments.

An attempt will be made to showcase the required factual information, their conceptual frameworks and hence, procedural systems, methods and regulations thereof that need to be understood in the process of working in the world of man made Environment, an emphasis being on Architectural projects.

An emphasis will also be made to showcase the necessary communication skills needed to foster a productive work environment; in order to interact and to negotiate with the different stakeholders involved.

The schedule has been prepared in such a way that the attendees will get to learn their way from the perspectives of the varied stakeholders: the academicians, the architects, the consultants and the developers about the aspects of policy, regulations thereof, management of people, material and time through a glimpse of realtime examples.

THEMES

Day 1 - Policy

Policy framework, laws, rules and regulations and implications on working with them.

Day 2 - Management

Process of monitoring, management of men, material and time both at the design and implementation stage on site through the lens of Architects and PMC.

Day 3 - Construction and Development

Perspectives from the managerial and developer position: Material Optimisation and Maximum FSI / Execution on Site, Negotiations with architects and so on.

Day 4 - Business Development

Identifying USPs as a design practice; Positioning in the market. Emphasis on making and pitching business proposals; and so on.

Day 5 - Pedagogy

Professional Practice pedagogy - Lecture followed by workshop focusing on teaching methodology by bringing examples from practice to the classroom. Emphasizing the roles of various stakeholders in the profession and equipping students to face challenges of the profession.

SIGNIFICANCE AND OBJECTIVES:

This five day faculty development programme encourages the attendees to relook at the idea of professional practice via the position of the varied stakeholders. Hence this will enable them to give a holistic picture of the subject matter to the students.

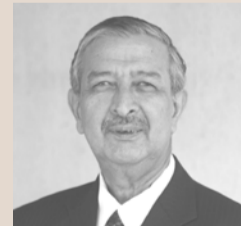
