### Preamble

Research is a systematic, vigorous investigation of a situation or problem in order to generate new knowledge or validate existing knowledge. It is a pivot for many emerging questions and plays a critical role for the furtherance of knowledge for the discipline and profession of architecture, as in all professions. Research in Architecture is gaining prominence and significance, in the current developments, pertaining to both the pedagogy and professional application, in the realm of the built environment. Although the domain of architecture has infinite research possibilities and offers a wide scope for inter disciplinary research, it has yet not been explored extensively. The methods of research in architecture are undergoing continuous changes. Traditional documented methodology is being infused with new trends to make the process of research more exciting and productive. This opens up new vistas in data collection and research methods and helps the researcher in extrapolating the findings to the real world of practice.

The objective of this five day training program is to demystify the process of research. It will focus on methodology, tools and techniques of research in architecture. It will highlight the steps involved in identification of a research area, making a research proposal and define the processes for taking the research work to culmination with effective clues to report writing.

The training program will include presentations, discussions and group work by participants.

### Key themes of the program would include:

- Types of Research in Architecture.
- Tools and techniques of research.
- Understanding historical research methods.
- Selecting areas of research in architecture.
- Framing research questions.
- Framing research proposals.
- Documentation and report writing.

The program is open to all architectural educators interested in pursuing research, research scholars and professionals.
