IDEA - Architectural Phenomenology

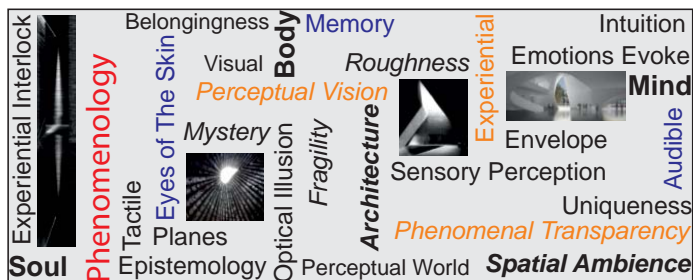
