	<p>The President informed the members that Minutes of the 217<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Executive Committee were circulated to the Hon'ble Members on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2020. No comments have been received from the Members.</p> <p>The Executive Committee after deliberations confirmed the Minutes.</p>
<b>ITEM NO.02</b>	<b>ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.</b>
	<p>The Executive Committee perused the action taken report as annexed with the Agenda.</p> <p>The Chairman informed the members that the Council is in receipt of a letter dated 25.06.2020 from the Secretary, Higher &amp; Technical Education Department, Govt. of Maharashtra, requesting to confirm the decision of Government of Maharashtra of cancellation of examinations of final year/ semester.</p>

	<p>The Executive Committee decided an appropriate communication be sent to the Government of Maharashtra as the MHRD and UGC have allowed conduct of examination in the month of September, 2020.</p> <p>The Executive Committee while discussing ATR on considering Item No.7 (i) and (ii) decided that appropriate communications be issued to the concerned at the earliest as per legal advice.</p> <p>The Executive Committee while discussing ATR on Item No.7 (iii) decided that the increment of 8% per annum be sanctioned to Prof. Jayashree Deshpande for the years 2017, 2018 and 2019 and arrears of the salary be paid to her accordingly.</p> <p>The Committee constituted by the EC shall make a comprehensive policy for sanction of increment to the contractual staff appointed in the Council, their terms of appointment and other details, and shall also examine the ARC matter and amendments in the Recruitment Rules of the Council.</p> <p>Ar. N. K. Negi, Member, of the Committee informed that Committee wish to take help of a consultant and in the next meeting he shall share the scope of work and charges to be paid to the Consultant for the assignment.</p> <p>The Committee while discussing Item No.7 (iv) noted that the Council has approached Dr. Rajeev Dhawan, Senior Advocate for settling the Review Petition of the Council and the Review Petition would be filed soon.</p>
<b>ITEM NO.03</b>	<b>CONDUCT OF NATA 2020 EXAMINATION</b>
	<p>The Chairman informed that the members that the meeting NATA 2020 Coordination Committee was held on 09.07.2020 discussed the modalities for the conduct NATA 2020 Examination.</p> <p>The NATA Committee noted that the examination dates for JEE Main and NEET have been postponed to the month of September, 2020 in view of nationwide threat posed by pandemic COVID-19, and considered that the dates for conduct of NATA 2020 needs to be reviewed.</p> <p>The NATA Committee discussed that the threat of COVID-19 is increasing day by day and keeping in mind the lockdown imposed and advisories and guidelines issued by various Central/State Governments, it would be advisable to conduct both Parts A &amp; B of NATA in an complete online mode and candidates may be asked to appear from their respective places of residence, so as to prevent them from travelling and gathering in large number and thus drastically reduce the health concerns of candidates.</p> <p>The NATA Committee observed that objective of the aptitude test is to judge the aesthetics sensitivity primarily rather than drawing skills, the mode of</p>

conduct for Part-A of NATA (i.e. Drawing Test) could also be considered and devised in an online manner.

The NATA Committee decided to seek opinion of the representatives of the NATA vendor i.e. Ginger Webs Pvt. Ltd. in the matter. Representative of Ginger Web informed the Committee that they have got the requisite technical expertise/ software and technology to conduct both Part-A & Part-B online mode and enable the candidates to appear in them from their places of residence or choice using desktops, laptops, iPads or mobile devices in a secure and monitored environment.

The vendor was requested to submit a proposal and process flow for conduct of both Parts A & B of NATA in a complete online mode with required safety and surveillance details at the earliest so that the same could be considered by the Committee.

The NATA Committee decided that Parts A & B of NATA be conducted in a complete online format and that the question pattern for Part-A (Drawing Test) and the duration of the tests may be revised suitably.

The NATA Committee further decided that the candidates may be provided option to either appear for online NATA 2020 from their respective places of residence/stay or at the Council allotted centres in case they do not have net connectivity or technical resources. Adequate centres with necessary infrastructure may be identified by the vendor for such candidates who wish to attend the online examination at centres.

The NATA Committee recommended to fix the date for 1st test of NATA 2020 in the third week of the August, preferably August 16 and 2nd test in the second week of the September, subject to confirmation from the NATA vendor. The Committee also decided that since NATA 2020 shall be a Complete online examination, two examinations sessions may be arranged on each day of test so that the candidates have the option to appear in any of the sessions in case they were unable to join earlier session due to any technical issue.

The Executive Committee deliberated in detail in the matter and noted that in view of exceptional circumstances prevalent due to pandemic of Covid 19 it will be wise to hold both, Part A and Part B, examinations online duly ensuring that the essence of the aptitude test is maintained in the tests.

The Committee, therefore, resolved as under :

**Resolved that :**

- (i) As recommended by the NATA Coordination Committee the NATA 2020 Examinations (Part A and Part B) be conducted online;

	<p>(ii) The syllabus of the Aptitude Test for NATA 2020 be revised so that the same can be conducted online;</p> <p>(iii) All the candidates registered for NATA 2020 Examination be informed about revision in the pattern of examination i.e. both the examination in online mode;</p> <p>(iv) The candidates be offered flexibility to either appear for the test from their home or from the designated test Centre of the Council and list of Test Centres will be made available on NATA Website;</p> <p>(v) In case a candidate is unable to complete the examination at home, due to any technical glitches or internet unavailability, a maximum time of 10 minutes time should be allowed to enable him/her to login back again after verifying credentials and resume the examination from the question, he/she was disconnected. However, the time lost by the candidate would be deducted from the duration of test left and the examination shall finish at scheduled time.</p> <p>If a candidate is unable to resume and complete the examination after being disconnected, he/she will have the option to appear for the second test only.</p> <p>(vi) There would be 4-5 unique questions papers sets and it would be ensured that questions are not repeated to candidates who have appeared in earlier session/ test.</p>
