	The Chairman informed the members that the Minutes of the 221 st Meeting of the Executive Committee are being finalized and will be circulated to the Hon'ble Members shortly.
ITEM NO.02	ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.
	The Committee was informed that the action taken report on the Minutes of the 221 st Meeting of the Executive Committee will be placed in the next meeting of the Executive Committee after finalization of the minutes.
ITEM NO.03	TO TAKE NOTE OF THE CONSTITUTION OF ENQUIRY COMMITTEE BY THE COUNCIL TO ENQUIRE INTO THE CONDUCT OF THE PARUL UNIVERSITY, VADODARA, FOR ORGANISING CHEATING IN NATA 2020 EXAMINATION.

	<p>The Chairman informed the members that the Parul University through its architecture faculty member(s) formed a WhatsApp group with the name “Parul Entrance Awareness” for providing NATA coaching to the prospective students.</p> <p>All the candidates in the group who opted for Home based Test were supplied live answers in the group by the students/faculty and other persons. One faculty Ar. Harshit Sadh was found to be admin of the group. The Council issued a show cause notice to Ar. Harshit Sadh about his involvement in the mass cheating organised for candidates who were part of their Whatsapp Group. Further, the Council has also issued a show cause notice to the University about its role in the matter.</p> <p>The Chairman further informed the members that an Inquiry Committee consisting of Ar. Amogh Kumar Gupta, Ar. Raneer Vadamuthu, Ar. Mala Mohan, Ar. Kapil Setia and Ar. Persi Engineer has been constituted to inquire into the role and conduct of the University for forming whatsapp group/ providing NATA Coaching Centre and providing live answers to the candidates were done at the instance of University for soliciting admissions of such students in the University. Further, pending inquiry into the conduct of the University, the Council also withheld the intake of the institution.</p> <p>The Executive Committee also noted that from the WhatsApp Chat of the Parul University Group about 47 students were prima-facie found to be cheating.</p> <p>The Chairman further informed the members that to ensure that the Institution does not obtain any ex-parte relief or any other order in its favour, the Council has filed a Caveat through its Advocate before Hon’ble Gujarat High Court.</p> <p>The Executive Committee deliberated in the matter in detail and expressed its serious concern over the role of the University and its faculty in organizing mass cheating in NATA 2020 examination and decided that the matter must be investigated properly, and further action would be taken in the matter based on the recommendation/ findings of the Committee.</p>
<p>ITEM NO.04</p>	<p>TO RECEIVE INFORMATION ON CONDUCT OF NATA 2020 EXAMINATION.</p>
	<p>The Chairman informed the members that the NATA 2020 Examination was conducted online on 29th August, 2020 and 12th September, 2020, as Home Based Test and Centre Based Test.</p> <p>Out of 30245 candidates 22843 candidates appeared for the exam for the Centre based Test/ Home Based Test. Out of 22843 candidates appeared for the test 19079 candidates qualified the NATA First Test.</p>

	<p>22286 candidates appeared for the home based test / centre based test. Out of 22286 candidates 19447 candidates qualified in the Second Test.</p> <p>426 candidates both in First Test and Second Test were found to be indulging in unfair means and their respective test has been cancelled. 06 candidates' both tests have been cancelled as they were found cheating and indulging in unfair means in both the tests.</p> <p>The Committee noted the information and was of the unanimous view that in future candidates should not be allowed for the NATA exam from their home and the exam must be conducted at the Examination Center only.</p> <p>The Chairman further informed the members M/S. Ginger Webs Pvt. Ltd. the NATA service provider have submitted its bills for making payment. The Executive Committee decided that the bills be placed before the NATA Coordination Committee along with a Note about the shortcomings and deficiencies found in working of the NATA service provider.</p>
<p>ITEM NO.05</p>	<p>TO RECEIVE INFORMATION REGARDING CIVIL WP ST. NO. 92945 OF 2020 FILED BY VIDYA VIKAS EDUCATION TRUST, MUMBAI, AGAINST COUNCIL OF ARCHITECTURE BEFORE HON'BLE COURT HIGH COURT.</p>
	<p>The Registrar-Secretary informed the members that the Vidya Vikas Education Trust, Mumbai has applied for introduction of B.Arch. Course for the academic session 2020-2021 from the Council. Its proposal was rejected by the Executive Committee in its 221st Meeting held on 23rd August, 2020, due to non-availability of qualified faculty.</p> <p>The Institution submitted a revised list of faculty members on 04.09.2020 and on 16.09.2020 it filed a Writ Petition against the Council before Hon'ble Bombay High Court.</p> <p>The matter came up for hearing on 22.09.2020 and the High Court asked the Council to examine whether the institution fulfils the requirement of faculty in terms of its letter dated 04.09.2020. The matter was listed in the Board on 26.09.2020 but did not reach and may again come on 28th or 29th September, 2020.</p> <p>The Committee was further informed that the Council has engaged Advocate Prakash Dhopatkar at Mumbai and Advocate Naveen R. Nath, New Delhi, for arguing in the matter. Both the advocates have been briefed about the faculty status of the Institution in terms of the requirements of 1983 Regulations of the Council.</p> <p>The Executive Committee perused the information/ documents furnished by the Institution and observed that the institution was not able to identify and appoint</p>

	the required eligible faculty as per 1983 Regulations, hence, its application for introduction of B.Arch. Course cannot be considered by the Council.
